INT./EXT. SCHOOL BUS - DAY

MS. WARREN Last warning, Rico. Cut it out or you'll be spending the entire day next to me.

Rico makes mocking faces towards Bert as he sits back down.

CUT TO:

EXT. THEME PARK (ENTRANCE) - DAY

Ms. Warren has the class gathered in front of the park to give last-minute instructions, but the students, eager to just get away from her already, are barely paying attention. Bert is the outlier; in front of the crowd, respectfully listening to Ms. Warren.

> MS. WARREN Okay guys, be sure to meet back here by four; no excuses! And use the buddy system; no one should be alone. Off you go!

Everyone rushes by Bert in excitement, leaving him standing there without a particular place to go. However, not wanting to Ms. Warren to notice him without a buddy, he decides to start walking.

A few steps in, he notices SAM, whose contagious bright smile and sweet personality makes her popular among her classmates, laughing with her gal-pal.

CUT TO:

3 EXT. THEME PARK - DAY

We see Bert sitting on a bench near a concession stand. He is the complete antithesis of the activity and noise going on around him. He hears a conversation going on behind him:

> SAM Are you don't wanna get on with me?

SAM'S FRIEND I just don't feel good right now... I haven't eaten all day.

SAM

Well, this sucks. Everyone else already got on... I don't want to go on it alone and--

BERT (Awkwardly) I'll go on with you.

SAM

Oh, hey Bert! Really? I thought you were terrified of roller coasters...

BERT Um, not anymore, I don't think...

SAM'S FRIEND (Whispering to Sam) Uhh, why are you even talking to this weirdo?

SAM (Whispering back) Be nice to Bert. I don't know why you guys are always making fun of him; he seems nice. (To Bert) Well, okay! Let's get in line before it gets any longer.

EXT. THEME PARK(IN-LINE FOR THE RIDE) - DAY

Bert watches anxiously as the coaster passes by overhead, roaring thunderously with its passengers screaming at the top of their lungs.

SAM

BERT

BERT

...excited.

SAM

Well, good. Me too.

From the same group we see Rico and his boys appear, laughing at the kid who just ran by. Rico acknowledges Sam and Bert as his group continues walking.

RICO

Hey Sam! How 'bout you and I-- Oh man, is that Nerdy Bertie? You've gotta be kidding, he'll piss his pants if he gets on this ride.

RICO'S BOY #1 (In laughter) Yeah, he must've forgotten what happened last year.

RICO

(To his boy) No one asked you, McFly. (To Sam) Sam, come find me afterwards sweetheart; I'll be where playas sip champagne and what not.

SAM Ignore him, Bert. The only thing he's good for is making a fool out of himself.

FADE TO:

INT./EXT. ROLLER COASTER BUILDING - DAY

A carny is seen pulling the shoulder harness down on Bert. As soon as he does so, a nervous Bert grips the handles so hard, his knuckles turn white.

> SAM Okay, this is it Bert.

Bert doesn't respond. Suddenly, the coaster jolts forward a bit, and starts to slowly move through the tunnel, towards the bright opening that leads outside.

Once they are outside, the ascension towards the top of the drop begins. Slowly but surely, the coaster inches its way higher and higher. To Bert, the climb up feels like an eternity and he starts to sweat. Sam looks over to Bert with a look of concern on her face.

FADE TO:

It's the end of the day and the class is gathering in front of the park. Everyone's tired from a long day of running around.

Bert is seen holding something in his hand. A CLOSE UP reveals that it is a photo taken during the ride. In the photo, Bert and Sam are screaming from the ride's drop. A MEDIUM SHOT then reveals Sam standing next to Bert. She starts happily talking to him, pointing at the photo for reference, both of them reliving the memory.

We zoom out slowly as the new friends are enjoying each other's company, and as Bert is seen appreciating his newfound friend.

We keep slowly zooming as we...
